- (1) EasyCard Sale & Add Value Machine in all Taipei Metro stations.

#### Types of EasyCard (deposit-based card)

- (1) Adult: Standard fare for the general public
- (2) Student: For registered students only
- (3) Concessionaire: Children eligible under relevant legislation to purchase children's tickets, seniors aged over 65 and persons registered as disabled.

\*When using cards other than an Adult EasyCard, please show appropriate ID. Persons using a Student EasyCard for bus services should carry their student ID card for inspection as required. If a valid student ID cannot be produced, the balance of the correct fare must be paid. Refusal to pay the balance and confirmation that the Student EasyCard was being used under false pretenses will lead to a fine of 50 times the fare or the confiscation of the Student EasyCard.

\*Please refer to the announcements from the relevant Social Welfare agency regarding dates when Senior, Charity and Escort cards are issued and related regulations.

\*For editions of EasyCard issued for special events and for commemorative cards, please refer to the terms and conditions attached to each card at time of purchase.

#### How to obtain EasyCard?

- (1) Adult and Concessionaire card cost NT\$100. They consist of a NT\$100 deposit.  
Disposable value must be added to the card before use.
- (2) When the disposable value is used up, value can be added to the card for continued use. The card can be returned for a refund of the deposit and balance of the disposable value.
- (3) If there is insufficient disposable value on the card to pay the Taipei Metro or bus fare, the fare will be deducted from the deposit. Value must be added to the card before it can be used again. Maximum deduction from the deposit is NT\$60.

## Value can be added to the EasyCard at the following locations:

1. Value-adding machines located at all Taipei Metro stations and some parking lot, and the value can be added in multiples of NT\$100..
2. The Information Counter at all Taipei Metro stations.
3. Convenience stores carrying the 「」 or 「」 logo (7-ELEVEN, FamilyMart, Hi-Life and OK), and the minimum amount of value adding is NT\$100.

**To protect consumer rights, all money from EasyCard disposable value is held in the EasyCard Prepaid Trust Fund managed by the First Bank. All EasyCard deposits are protected by a 100% refund guarantee issued by First Bank.**

Available for all station between Suao-Keelung-Pingtung, including Mountain & Coast lines, Pixgin lines, Shenao line, Neiwai lines, Liujia lines, Jiji lines and Shalun lines.



\*EasyCard can be used for all train services except tour trains, group trains, Taroko Express, Puyuma Express and other TRA designated trains (special and reserve seat services). EasyCard users enjoy a 10% discount on fares for traveling distance under 70 km.




